We carry out the following activities with our vessel, equipment and volunteers:

Cleaning the seas of marine litter:

Ghost nets.

- Cleanups with volunteer divers and equipment:

Ghost nets are fishing nets that have been abandoned, lost, or otherwise discarded in the ocean, seas, lakes, and rivers. These nets, often nearly invisible in the dim light, can be left tangled on shipwrecks, a reef or drifting in the open sea. Thousands of marine animals are injured and killed by ghost nets.



Plastic waste.

- Collecting plastic waste from the oceans, seas and inland waters.

We support and provide assistance to organizations that collect plastic waste. With our ship, crew and equipment we help to remove plastic waste from the water.

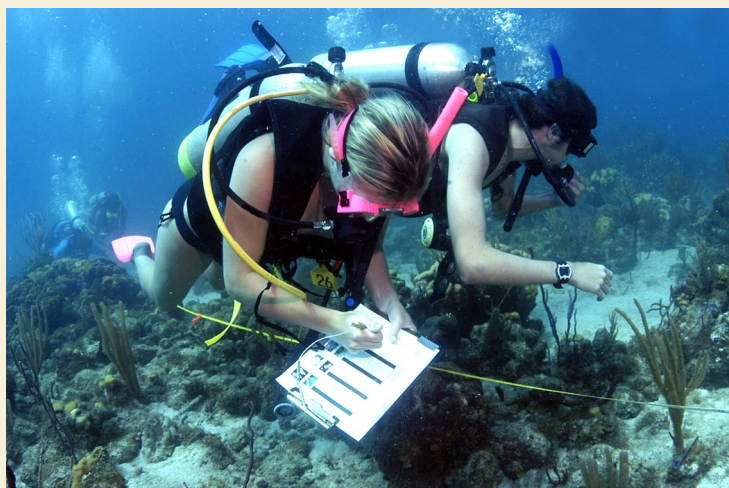
8 million tons of plastic waste found in the ocean each year. If this trend continues, by the year 2050 there will be more plastic than fish in the ocean by weight.



Research and studies:

Marine Biology.

Marine biology studies organisms living in marine ecosystems and their interactions with the environment. Aqua Mundial provides assistance and support to marine research institutes for scientific studies and observations of marine habitats

A group of concerned people, with different backgrounds, who have been to many places in the world for their work and expeditions and have seen the enormous pollution and destruction of the environment, decided in 2023 to actually help , voluntarily, with the protection of the environment by using their dedication, experience and expertise. We are going to take action. After consultation it was decided that this can best be done with a vessel that is suitable for scientific research, diving clean-up operations, education and promotion. After a long search we found a seaworthy multifunctional trawler, in good condition, 31 meters long and 7 meters wide which can handle all tasks.

We bought it and granted it to the foundation.

The first steps has been taken but much still needs to be done. The ship must be made as environmentally friendly as possible. Adjustments need to be made to be able to do research and clean-up projects with the right equipment and**we can use your help with it !!**
